
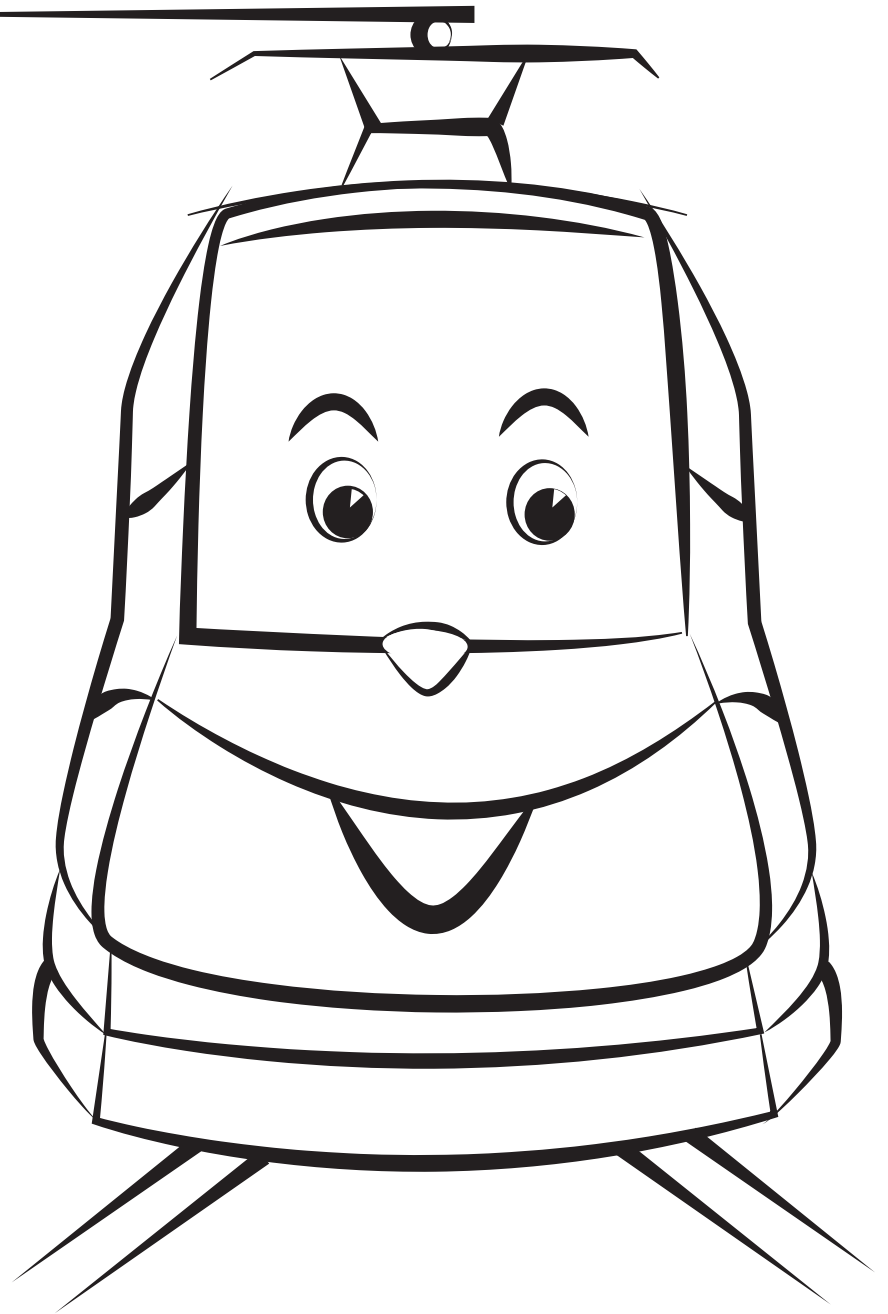


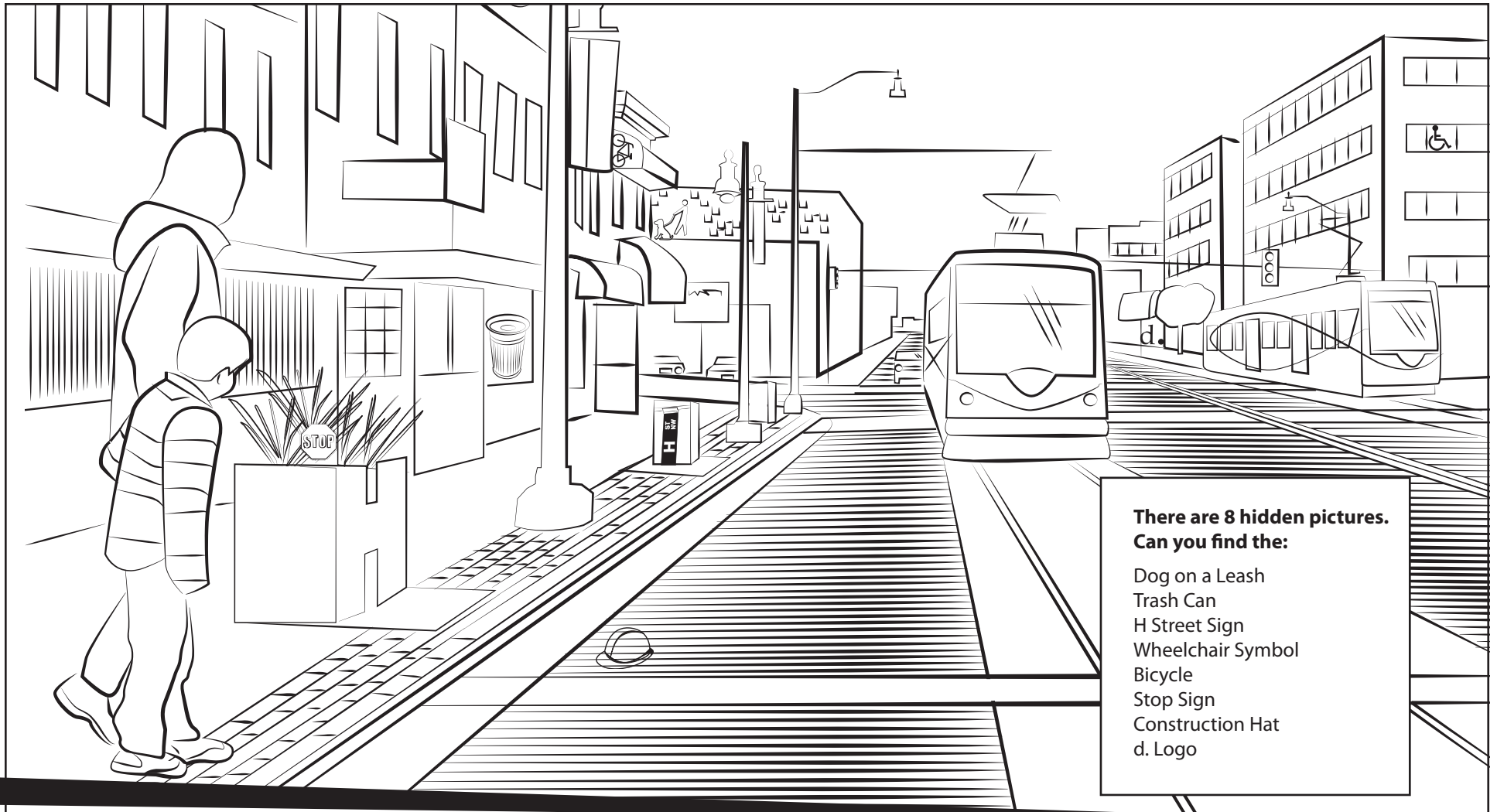

What is a streetcar?

A streetcar is a small railroad car that moves on tracks running through city streets and is used to carry passengers. Streetcars are powered by electricity.

- Always look both ways before crossing the tracks. Never cross in front of a moving streetcar, bus, or car.
- Use crosswalks.
- Obey signs and traffic signals.

Be Aware-Stay Alert

When walking, be aware of your environment and always proceed with caution when interacting with the streetcar.

- Never cross or run in front of an approaching streetcar or between two stopped vehicles.
- Wait until traffic has stopped before crossing and only cross at designated crosswalks. Never assume a driver sees you.
- Be aware of your environment and recognize that the streetcar is operating in mixed traffic.
- Stay alert - streetcars are quiet vehicles, so listen for their bell.
