



## Midline Substation Construction Impact Area

Construction begins in June 2013 to install the midline substation at the southwest corner of 12<sup>th</sup> and H Streets and will last about one month. This substation is a safe, enclosed system that will power the streetcar. Its design was approved by the Commission of Fine Arts in May 2013. The biggest impact of this installation will be a sidewalk closure and pedestrian detour, however, lane closures and parking restrictions are also expected. The Khan's Bar & Grill patio will remain open for business throughout construction, although portions of the patio may be occasionally affected.

### Impacts

- One-day lane closures surrounding the southwest corner during delivery of the substation
- Sidewalk closures surrounding the substation for one month during installation
- Daytime parking restrictions surrounding the substation for one month during installation
